Who Can Apply

Undergraduate or graduate students currently enrolled in the IIGE Global Network Universities and Ludus Labs-affiliated institutions who are in good academic standing (recommended minimum overall GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale) are eligible to apply.

Please carefully read all the instructions below before completing the application form. Kansai University is not responsible for incomplete applications.

- ① Your name should be entered into this application form **exactly as you wish for it to appear on your program certificate**. Changes cannot be made to certificates after they are issued.
- ② Submit a brief statement (150-300 words in English), explaining what you hope to gain by participating in this program.
- *We recommend that you type your statement in a separate document and copy and paste it into the application form.
- 3 English language proficiency certification is NOT required.

3. Program Fees

JPY20,000 Free of charge for eligible students

*This year, we are offering scholarships in the form of full tuition fee waivers to all accepted participants, so there will be no actual cost for participating in this program. However, if you cancel in the middle of the program, you will be required to pay the program fee of 20.000 yen as a cancellation fee.

4. Requirements

Language Proficiency Requirements

The program will be conducted entirely in English. CEFR B2 Level (TOEFL iBT 72+, IELTS 5.5+, Cambridge Examination 160+) English proficiency is recommended for non-native speakers.

*Proof of language certification is NOT required.

Technical Requirements

This program will be conducted online, and requires students to have:

- a stable internet connection able to handle video calls without interruption
- a quality microphone/headset
- a functioning camera-equipped PC

Online Platforms

<u>Virbela</u>, *Zoom, Discord, Miro (tentative)

Lectures and program activities will be conducted LIVE in English via <u>Virbela</u>. *The first meeting, however, will take place LIVE via Zoom.

Students will be required to register an account with <u>Virbela</u>. Further information will be provided to students upon enrollment.

5. Course Credits

Digital Certificates will be issued to students who complete the Program. Students' host institutions may interpret the certificate to be creditable.

6. Digital Badges

Students who successfully complete the program will be eligible for a digital badge to be issued by IIGE (Kansai University) within 3 months of program completion.

Digital badges issued by IIGE are verifiable and meet the qualifications for IMS Global Open Badges 2.0.

Please note that IIGE/Kansai University **does NOT** issue credits, transcripts (official or unofficial), letters of credit approval, nor any similar documentation for this program.

7. Commitment [IMPORTANT]

Students **must be available** during the three weeks of the program to join all 10 lectures and participate in group work.

Please note that **group work is an obligatory part** of this program. Students who are unable to commit to the development of the group project are not eligible for this program.

IIGE will notify students' home institutions of the students' performance in this program. Non-committal participation or dropping out partway through the program **without an appropriate reason** will result in students' disqualification from participation in future programs.

8. Announcement of Program Selection Results

Please note that students are not guaranteed a spot in this program, and selection criteria are at the discretion of Kansai University. All selections are final.
